Recently we sent your family an e-mail with registration information for our 2010 summer. This packet is to follow-up on that e-mail. If you have already begun the application process please consider passing these materials on to a new prospective family. If you haven't begun the process you can use these materials or log onto our website.

**Take Advantage of Discounted 2010 Fees!!!**

Economic conditions continue to challenge many families in our community and, in response, our Board of Directors has taken an unprecedented step to help by **freezing 2010 tuition fees at 2009 rates for all campers who pay in full, or for whom signed payment plans are received in our office, by December 1, 2009.** Visit our web site, [www.ramah.org](http://www.ramah.org) for your 2010 enrollment application packet. Please take advantage of this opportunity to save money by completing the application today. Scholarship applications will be available on our website in January. In addition, we will post information about other forms of assistance that may be available through your local Jewish community as they become available.

**Each year we work hard to make every summer better than the one before.** In 2010 we introduced many new programs like our Ultimate Frisbee *chug*, featured guest instructors in areas like basketball and rap music, upgraded our daily menu and strengthened transportation services. The positive feedback on our 2009 summer has been overwhelming, and will use the constructive feedback to strengthen our 2010 program.

**Carefully note the dates of the session you select to ensure your camper(s) will be able to be at camp for the full session.** Campers should not come late or leave early for summer school, vacations or other commitments. However, if either the end of or start of school dates conflict with the camp schedule by a couple of days, please be in touch **immediately** so that, if possible, special arrangements may be made. If you plan to attend our full session camp (8 weeks) please be aware of our 3 night intersession from July 19th to July 22<sup>nd</sup>, during which your child will need to leave camp for home.

**After careful consideration we have decided to shift the structure of our Geshet program and only offer 2-week introductory encampments for these campers.** Feedback from families and assessment from our staff indicate clearly that campers feel more positive about their first Ramah experience when they are with us for at least 2-weeks, giving them enough time to make friends, settle into the routine and enjoy their activities. Enrollment will be limited, so act quickly.

**How to Register:**

We recommend that all applications be returned as quickly as possible. Returning summer 2009 campers, siblings of returning campers, waitlisted campers in 2009, or returning campers who took a hiatus from Camp Ramah in California in 2009 can submit an application immediately and will be processed in the order in which the completed

applications are received in our office. New enrollments also should be submitted immediately and will be processed after October 16, 2009 according to the order in which they are received.

- In addition to our standard application that can be downloaded and completed by hand, we are happy to introduce a writeable PDF Application for you to type and complete on your computer, print, sign and mail to our office with your payment.
- **Please complete all the highlighted sections of the application.** Applications will only be processed if they are complete with signatures, payments and/or payment arrangements. **DO NOT E-MAIL AND DO NOT FAX.** E-mailed, faxed or incomplete applications (including those with no deposit) will **NOT** be processed.
- Please enclose your check payable to **Camp Ramah in California** or include VISA/Master Card information. ***If you are enrolling several children and paying the deposits with a check, please use a separate check for each child.*** Families seeking financial assistance and are unable to send the full deposit should read below for more information.

**\*\*Please note: If you do not have Adobe Professional you will NOT be able to save an electronic version of your application, and must complete it from start to finish in your first attempt. Once completed we recommend that you print two copies – one for our office and one for your records.**

#### **Financial Assistance & Payment Plans:**

Financial Aid applications will be available online after January 4, 2010. Please visit our website: [http://www.ramah.org/re\\_financial\\_resources.php](http://www.ramah.org/re_financial_resources.php) for the application. The application and all completed documents must be received in the camp office no later than **March 2, 2010**. The financial resources page also provides information on other funding sources from Ramah and other organizations and will be updated as information becomes available.

We are making a variety of payment plan options available to you sooner than ever before so that you can spread out your payments. To view payment plan options and to sign up for this program please complete the required forms, available after August 14<sup>th</sup> on our website at [www.ramah.org/re\\_financial\\_resources.php](http://www.ramah.org/re_financial_resources.php).

#### **Cancellations:**

The Ramah cancellation and change to enrollment policy is as follows:

1. All cancellations or changes **must** be submitted online through the Ramah website ([www.ramah.org/re\\_forms.php](http://www.ramah.org/re_forms.php))! Phone requests for changes cannot be honored. All deposits are refundable less the following NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE administrative fees:

2. Administrative fees will be charged for all withdrawn campers.
3. **There will be no tuition refunds granted after June 1, 2010.**
4. Any changes in enrollment will be subject to the above policy.

In fairness to other families, please enroll only for the session you plan to attend. If you enroll for two sessions, and subsequently drop a session, **you will be charged a full cancellation fee for the session you drop** (i.e. cancellation fees CANNOT be applied to the other session).
